[1]. Vide this common order CR No.5430 of 2016 and CR No.4765 of 2017 are being decided.

[2]. Both the petitions have been filed against the orders dated 28.07.2016 and 12.01.2017 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.) Jalandhar vide which the petitioner was not allowed to lead additional evidence after expiry of time period granted by the High Court. Since common issue is involved in both the petitions, therefore, for brevity facts are being culled out from

CR No.5430 of 2016.

[3]. Perusal of the record would reveal that while deciding Civil Revision No.4061 of 2012 on 11.01.2016 filed by the present petitioner, a period of two weeks was granted to the petitioner to tender the documents in his evidence subject to payment of costs of Rs.5000/-.

[4]. Further, perusal of orders dated 22.01.2016, 04.07.2016 and 12.07.2016 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.) Jalandhar would show that though the costs were deposited and accepted by the plaintiff, but the required documents were not tendered in time prescribed by the High Court. In order dated 04.07.2016, defendant was directed to tender the documents and the evidence of DW's for 07.07.2016. In a subsequent order dated 12.07.2016, factum of application to be filed by the defendant was also noticed.

[5]. In view of aforesaid facts on record, I do not see any error of jurisdiction in the impugned order passed by the trial Court. Both the revision petitions are accordingly dismissed.
