Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for some time prays for permission to withdraw the revision petition provided that he has given six months time to hand over the vacant possession of the premises.

Keeping in view the aforesaid prayer made which is not opposed by the learned counsel for the caveator-respondents/landlord, petitioner is granted six months time to hand over the vacant possession of the premises provided that he files an undertaking before the Rent Controller that he will hand over the vacant possession of the premises on or before 28.02.2019, petitioner would also clear all the arrears of rent or mesne profits as fixed by the learned First Appellate Court if any and would further pay rent for six months in advance within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
