The present revision petition has been filed against the order dated 06.01.2018 whereby the application moved by the plaintiff at the stage when the defendant had closed the evidence in suit for recovery of amount under Section 45 of the Indian Evidence Act for taking up the assistance and aid to examine the signature of the defendant in affidavit bearing a witness, which has been examined by the petitioner, has been declined by the Court below.
