AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Today learned counsel for respondent no. 2 appears and submits that he has taken instructions to the effect that the amount of compensation awarded has already been deposited with the Tribunal and that no appeal has been filed by the insurance company against the Award dated 04.04.2018.

That being so, as regards the compensation awarded to petitioner no. 1, i.e. the widow of the deceased (70% of the total compensation of Rs. 15,93,200/-, along with interest thereupon), is ordered to be released to her immediately, without insisting upon any indemnity bonds to be filed by her.

However, as regards the share of petitioner no. 2, i.e. the minor son of the deceased, (to the extent of 30% of the aforesaid compensation amount), that shall continue to remain in a fixed deposit, till the time he attains majority.
