Learned counsel states that he does not press the revision petition however, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the learned trial Court to decide the case at the earliest in view of petitioner No.1 being an old lady while petitioner No.2 is the daughter of petitioner No.1.

Considering the fact that dispute is inter se family members with the mother and daughter on one side and the sons/brothers on the other side, it is deemed appropriate to dispose of the revision petition by directing the learned trial Court to consider and decide the civil suit as expeditiously as possible in view of the fact that petitioner No.1 is more than 65 years of age.

Accordingly, the revision petition is disposed of by directing the learned trial Court to consider and decide the civil suit as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of one year.
