This revision petition is arising out of the order passed by the learned Executing Court.

During the course of proceedings pending before this Court, parties have entered into a settlement. A written deed of compromise has been filed, which is not only signed by both the parties but has also been signed by the counsels representing them. The deed of compromise is taken on record as mark 'C'. Parties are present in Court, who are identified by their respective counsels. They admit correctness of the deed of compromise.

In view thereof, the revision petition is disposed of in terms of the deed of compromise. The order passed by the learned trial Court shall stand modified and the petitioner would pay a sum of Rs.1,60,000/- in full and final settlement of the claim.

account of the petitioner has already been attached and the learned Executing Court would be entitled to withdraw a sum of Rs.1,60,000/- and pay to the respondent.

In view thereof, the revision petition is disposed of.

Parties shall remain bound by the written deed of compromise before the Court and the statement made.
