By producing photostat copy of order dated 06.10.2018 passed by Civil Judge (Senior Division), Bathinda, learned counsel for respondent No.3 submits that an amount of Rs.25,31,515/- has already been paid to the decree holder and the said payment is inclusive of costs as well. There was no order regarding interest in the decree and in view of above, this revision petition has rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner however is not in a

position to refute the statement of fact made by learned counsel for respondent No.3.

In view of statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.3, this revision petition is ordered to be rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner that in case the statement of fact is found to be incorrect, he can move appropriate application for revival of the revision petition.
