AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This revision has been filed against the concurrent orders of the Courts below allowing ejectment of the petitioner-tenant from the demised premises.

Today on instructions from his client the counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner will not press this petition on merits and will vacate the premises voluntarily on or before 31.12.2018 without forcing the respondent to press his execution petition.

Counsel for the respondent has also taken instructions from his client and the following agreement has been arrived at between the parties.

It has been agreed that up till 28.02.2018 the petitioner will pay the amount

liable to pay only contractual rent and the entire amount will be paid by the petitioner by 06.04.2018 along with an undertaking that he will hand over vacant possession on 31.12.2018.

In the circumstances, the revision petition is disposed of in the above terms, subject to the deposit of all arrears and future rent along with an undertaking on or before 06.04.2018.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
