AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that this petition, by which the petitioner has challenged the order of the learned trial Court (Guardian Judge), granting interim visitation rights to the respondent to visit the children of the petitioner and the respondent, can be disposed of in terms of the order of this Court dated 25.10.2018.

2. Vide that order this Court had directed that (during the pendency of the petition of the respondent herein seeking custody of the children of the parties), the respondent-father would have a right to meet the children at the family Court at Hoshiarpur on the first Saturday of every month between 10.30 am to 12.30 pm, with the mother, i.e. the petitioner, to be not in the same room where the children are meeting their father, i.e. the respondent herein.

This arrangement would continue during the pendency of the petition before the learned trial Court.

3. Naturally, that Court would ensure that no untoward incident takes place by way of any fight breaking out etc. between the parties, and that the children are given an environment in which genuinely a bond can be tried to be forged with their father. In the initial meetings, two mediators (one lady and one gentleman) shall be present for about half an hour to 45 minutes, after which, depending upon the situation to be reported to the learned Court by the mediators, the mediators would leave the room and leave the children with their father.

4. This petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms, with a request also made to the learned trial Court to conclude the proceedings in the petition pending before it, within six months from today.
