Pursuant to the order dated December 11, 2017 passed by this Court, learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the National Highways Authority of India (hereinafter referred to as the NHAI) has deposited the amount of compensation with the competent authority-cum-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Mukerian i.e. respondent No.4 for onward disbursement to the claimant-petitioners. Photocopy of the communication dated 07.03.2018 sent by the NHAI to the respondent No.4 has been produced. The same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2, on instructions from Col. M.K. Jain, who is present in the Court, states that the NHAI has accorded

approval of payment of the admissible amount of compensation for onward disbursement to the claimant-petitioners.

In view of the communication dated 07.03.2018 as produced by the respondent No.2, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press this petition at this stage.

Dismissed as not pressed at this stage.

However, it is made clear that if there is no other impediment with the respondent No.4, the amount so deposited by the NHAI be released to the claimant-petitioners as per their entitlement as observed in the award dated 29.05.2013 passed by the Arbitrator.
