ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

Defendant No.11 is in the civil revision petition against the order passed by the learned trial court, refusing to set aside the ex parte proceedings against him.

Learned counsel appearing for the plaintiffs has stated that he has no objection if ex parte proceedings are set aside, however, with direction to the learned trial court to decide the suit within six months.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has accepted the offer made by the learned counsel for the respondents-plaintiffs.

Keeping in view the consensus arrived at, the revision petition is allowed. The ex parte proceedings against defendant No.11 are set aside. However, defendant No.11 would file his written statement within 10 days from today and thereafter the court would expeditiously proceed with the matter and decide the suit positively within six months. If the court comes to the conclusion that any of the party is delaying the proceedings, it would be free to proceed with the matter.
