An order passed under Section 24 of Hindu Marriage Act passed in the petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act has been assailed in the present revision petition by the husband-petitioner.

Perusal of the impugned order would show that an amount of Rs.12,000/- per month has been awarded as an interim maintenance in favour of the respondent besides awarding an amount of Rs.11,000/- towards litigation expenses.

At the time of issuance of notice of motion on 31.08.2018, a direction was issued to the petitioner to deposit demand draft in a sum of Rs.20,000/- in the name of the respondent payable to her on her appearance.

As per office report, direction has not been complied with by the petitioner till date.

Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

It appears that the petitioner has lost track of representing his case anymore.

Dismissed.
