At the time of issuance of notice of motion on 31.01.2017, operation of the impugned order was stayed and it was made clear that in case petitioner fails to deposit an amount of Rs.1,50,000/- within two weeks from that date, interim order passed shall stand vacated. The compliance of said order was not made and the interim order was vacated on 13.09.2017. After vacation of stay, conditional warrants issued against the petitioner were required to be executed in all probability. From 13.09.2017 till date, conditional warrants might have been executed against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to state the actual status of execution of conditional warrants.

He submits that despite his communication, petitioner is not responding to his call.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present revision petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
