Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite repeated efforts, he did not get any response from his client to produce certified copies of the interlocutory orders of the Assistant Collector Grade-I, to support his contention that partition proceedings amongst the parties are still pending before the Collector. Therefore, he is unable to produce the same.

Main plank of the argument in this revision petition of the petitioner is that partition proceedings are still going on and if the impugned order is not set aside, he would suffer irreparable loss. Since the petitioner could not produce any evidence in support of assertion aforesaid, therefore, this petition is dismissed being meritless, inasmuch as the stand of the opponent of the petitioner is that partition proceedings have already been finalized and concluded.
