Suit of the present petitioner for permanent injunction was decreed and vide judgment and decree dated 26.10.1965 passed by learned Sub Judge III Class, Zira the defendants were perpetually enjoined from digging the drain from the land in dispute. Now, claiming that the said judgment is being violated and application for Contempt of Court was filed, which was dismissed.

I am of the view that prima facie, application is not maintainable. If decree is to be enforced, Execution application lies and not the application for Contempt of Court.

Resultantly, the present revision petition stands dismissed.

Since the main case has been dismissed, therefore, the pending CM, if any, also stands disposed of.
