After arguing at length, learned counsel concedes that objections with regard to exemption from attachment of residential house in terms of Section 60 (1)(ccc) CPC as well as the respondent-decree-holder owing a sum of approximately ₹6,00,000/- to the petitioner in terms of decision dated 17.8.2016 in RT No.17 dated 5.5.2010/08.08.2012, CIS No.RP/7130/2013 were not raised before the learned Executing Court, therefore, permission be granted to withdraw the revision petition with liberty to move appropriate application before the Executing Court in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
