This revision has been filed against the judgment dated 13.01.2017 passed by the Rent Controller and the judgment dated 13.07.2018 passed by the Appellate Authority allowing eviction of the petitioners from the demised shop.

Today on instructions from his client the counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioner will not press this petition on merits and will vacate the premises voluntarily on or before 31.12.2019 without forcing the respondent No.1-landlord to file/press an execution petition and will continue to pay the rent in advance by the 7th of every month @ Rs.5000/- per month and also pay the other admissible charges regularly.

Counsel for the respondent No.1 on instructions from his client

has also accepted this offer on the condition that the petitioners will file an undertaking to the above effect within two months, failing which, this revision be deemed to be dismissed.

Counsel for the petitioners has accepted this condition.

In the circumstances, the revision petition is disposed of in the above terms, and subject to the deposit of rent @ Rs.5000/- p.m. and undertaking to this effect within two months.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
