During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from the respondent, states that on account of birth of a son during the pendency of the proceedings under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 before the learned trial court, the respondent is ready and willing to make payment of ₹10,000/- per month as maintenance towards the upkeep of the child in addition to sum of ₹6,000/- being paid to the petitioner.

The same satisfies the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, it is ordered that the respondent would make a payment of ₹10,000/- per month as maintenance to the child with effect from the date of birth of child i.e. 2.8.2016 in addition to the sum of ₹6000/- being paid to the petitioner.

The revision petition stands disposed of in above terms.
