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**AMIT RAWAL, J. (Oral)**

The present revision is directed against the main order dated 28.11.2002 (Annexure P-2), whereby Collector had condoned the delay while entertaining the appeal preferred by the respondents. The aforementioned order was assailed before the authorities by filing application, appeal revision etc., which had been dismissed vide orders dated 24.8.2004 (Annexure P-5), 11.5.2006 (Annexure P-6), 21.5.2013 (Annexure P-8) and 21.5.2014 (Annexure P-10).

Mr.Ajay Ghanghas, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 submits that during the pendency of the revision petition, the Collector had decided the appeal after condoning the delay vide order dated 10.6.2016 and the petitioners have availed the remedy of

revision before the Commissioner.

Mr.R.S.Chauhan, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that liberty may be granted to the petitioners to take all the pleas available to them in the pending revision petition in accordance with law.

In view of such prayer, with the aforementioned liberty, the revision is permitted to be withdrawn.
