Learned counsel for the petitioner-plaintiff submits that though undoubtedly sufficient number of opportunities had been granted by the learned trial Court to the petitioner to lead his evidence, however the petitioner only seeks two more dates to complete his evidence (subject of course to counsel for the respondent taking time for cross-examination)

On specific query Mr.Pathania submits that no evidence for the defendant has been led so far.

Subject to the aforesaid contention being correct, i.e. no evidence of the defendant has been led so far, it is considered appropriate that the petitioner be granted two opportunities to lead his evidence subject to payment of costs of Rs.5000/- to the respondent-defendant.

Of course, any time sought and taken by counsel for the defendant to cross examine the witnesses of the plaintiff, shall be excluded from the said two opportunities granted.
