It is not clear how the petitioner claims to be juristic person. The appellate authority has found that Nirmal Panchayati Akharha has neither produced any document that it was a body registered under the Societies Act nor there was any document to show that Mahant Satpal Singh was authorised to institute the rent petition.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail appropriate remedy afresh in case any individual/juristic person is legally entitled to do so.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid, if permissible in law.
