After arguing at length, learned counsel for the respondent states that the respondent will withdraw the divorce petition which has been filed in derogation of Section 14 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 but liberty be granted to file fresh petition in accordance with law.

In view of the statement of learned counsel for the respondent, the revision petition is disposed of as having become infructuous. Respondent shall file appropriate application before the learned trial Court for withdrawal of the divorce petition filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. However, respondent would be at liberty to file a fresh petition for divorce under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, in accordance with law.
