The State had filed the present appeal for challenging the judgment dated 26.5.2004 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge (Adhoc) Jhajjar, whereby, the sole accused/respondent, namely, Narender, stood acquitted of the charges under Sections 302/34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act.

As per the Office report, the acquitted accused/respondent expired on 12.11.2005. In this regard, death certificate has been placed on record.

It being an appeal against acquittal and the accused/respondent has died during its pendency, the appeal abates and, accordingly, disposed of in terms of Section 394 Cr.P.C.
