AJAY TEWARI, J. (ORAL)

This revision has been filed against the order dated 11.09.2018 passed by the Executing Court, Mohali whereby the warrants of possession has been issued against the petitioners.

Parties as identified by their counsel are present in person. With the intervention of the counsel, this dispute has been settled. Today the petitioners have handed over two cheques of Rs.86,000/- each to the respondents (which represent the rent upto 31.12.2018). It has been agreed that the petitioners shall hand over vacant possession of the premises in dispute to the respondents on or before 31.12.2018. The petitioners have also undertaken that they would deliver the FORM-16 as well as an amount of Rs.60,000/- (representing the TDS amount) and an amount of

Rs.1,68,000/- (representing the TDS amount which has already been deducted) to the respondents on or before 15.12.2018. The respondents also undertake that once the petitioners fulfil their end of the bargain, they would refund the security amount of Rs.2,50,000/- to the petitioners forthwith. The parties have also agreed that they will submit their respective undertakings to the above effect before the Executing Court tomorrow i.e. on 26.10.2018.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms and the impugned order is set aside subject to the aforesaid conditions.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
