Wife has challenged the order passed by the learned trial Court dated 20.09.2017 by which the learned Court refused to set aside the ex parte proceedings. On 27.04.2018, this Court had put the petitioner to terms and directed her to file an affidavit. The terms are as under:-

“Counsel for the petitioner is directed to file an affidavit to the following effect:-

- (i) The petitioner would conclude her entire evidence within a period of 2 months from the first date to be fixed by this Court;*
- (ii) The petitioner shall not create any further obstacle in completion of the trial;*
- (iii) The petitioner would pay a costs of Rs.50,000/-.”*

The petitioner has filed an affidavit and has undertaken to abide by the terms. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that her client has brought Rs.35,000/- in cash for payment to the respondent-

husband. This Court has directed to the petitioner to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the amount of Rs.15,000/- has already been deposited as ordered on 25.09.2017.

In view of the undertaking filed, the petition is disposed of. The amount of Rs.15,000/- as deposited by the petitioner pursuant to the order dated 25.09.2017 shall be remitted by the Registrar to the learned trial Court. The petitioner would pay the remaining amount of Rs.35,000/- by way of draft in the name of respondent-husband on the next date of hearing.

In view of the aforesaid, the revision petition is disposed of directing the petitioner to conclude her entire evidence, within a period of two months, from the first date to be fixed by the learned trial Court.
