The present petition had been filed to challenge therein order dated 17.09.2018 passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Ambala (for short, the Executing Court) through which third party objections filed by the petitioner against execution of decree dated 23.09.2016 have been dismissed.

When the matter came up for hearing before this Court on 28.09.2018, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he does not challenge the impugned order on merits and while filing an affidavit of the petitioner, which was taken on record as Mark-A, prayed that since the petitioner is an old lady; is suffering from chronic high blood pressure and with whom is also residing her married daughter who has been deserted by her husband, she be granted 03 months time to vacate the suit property. Notice of the petition was issued to the contesting respondent No.1, in pursuance of which, Mr. Manu Rastogi, Advocate has put in appearance. He

submits that he has no objection if the petitioner is granted 03 months time

to vacate the suit property.

In view of the above, the petitioner is permitted to occupy the suit property for a period of 03 months from today. It is further directed that the petitioner shall remain bound by the affidavit filed by her in Court (Mark-A) and any violation of the same would entitle the respondent to not only seek forthwith possession of the suit property by taking police help, but would also entitled the respondent to initiate against the petitioner proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

The petition is disposed of in the above terms.
