Prayer in this petition filed under Section 227 of the Constitution of India is for setting aside the order dated 07.09.2015 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned District Judge, Chandigarh whereby application filed by the petitioner under Section 24 of the CPC read with Section 151 CPC for transfer of the suit to be heard along with suit titled as “Darbara Singh vs. Gurdial Kaur and others” has been dismissed.

No one has put appearance on behalf of respondents No.1, 7 to 9.

At this stage, learned counsels appearing for respondents No.2, 3 to 6, 10, 11 and 12 submit that they have no objection in case both the suits titled as *Satpal Singh and another vs. Darbara Singh and others* pending before Ms. Rekha Chaudhary, Civil Judge (Junior Division) and *Darabara Singh vs. Gurdial Kaur @ Dialo and others* pending in the Court of Mr. Gurkiran Singh, Civil Judge (Junior Division) are ordered to be clubbed together and taken up by one Court, as the dispute in both the civil suits is inter linked and relates to the same land.

In view of the consensus so arrived at between the parties, this petition is disposed of with a direction to Civil Judge (Sr. Division) or other authorised Civil Judge to consolidate both the civil suits and decide the same in accordance with law.
