Counsel for the petitioner(s) after arguing for sometime, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present revision petition. However, he submits that the observations made by the Court while deciding the application for temporary injunction should not prejudice the Court while finally deciding the suit.

Needless to say that such observations are made only for the purpose of deciding the application and such observations while deciding the application filed under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC are never binding on the Court while deciding the suit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) has further requested that since the suit is pending for almost 5 years and 8 months, therefore, the direction be issued to the Court to decide the suit within the time frame.

Keeping in view the request made, the learned trial Court is

requested to expedite the trial of the case and make sincere efforts to decide the same within a period of 9 months from today.
