This revision has been filed against the concurrent orders of the Courts below allowing ejectment of the petitioner-tenant from the demised premises.

After arguing for some time the matter has been settled with the intervention of the learned Counsel for the parties. Today on instructions from his client the learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioners will hand over the premises voluntarily on or before 30.9.2019 without forcing the respondent to file/press an execution petition and will continue to pay the rent in advance by 7th of every month on contractual rate and alongwith other admissible charges regularly.

Learned counsel for the respondent after taking instructions from the respondent has also accepted this offer on the condition that the

petitioners will file an undertaking to the above effect and deposits the entire arrears if any upto 30.09.2019 before the Executing Court/Trial Court on or before 31.10.2018, failing which, this revision should be deemed to be dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has accepted this condition.

In the circumstances, the revision petition is disposed of in the above terms, and subject to the deposit of all arrears and undertaking on or before 31.10.2018 and further to pay rent in advance by 7th of every month.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
