Kuldeep Singh, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in consequent to the award passed by the Tribunal (constituted under the Improvement Trust Act), the compensation was ordered to be paid on account of acquisition of land.

CWP No.21678 of 2016 was filed before this Court challenging the said award which was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 14.3.2017 (Annexure P4). The said order was challenged before the Apex Court, which ordered the amount to be put in a Fixed Deposit. Now, the said petition has been dismissed. However, the Executing Court is not deciding the matter regarding disbursement of the compensation.

In these circumstances, without going into the controversy, the present revision petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Patiala to hear both the parties within two weeks and pass a speaking order regarding disbursement of compensation.
