Pursuant to the order dated 9.10.2018, by this application copies of the pay slips pertaining to the salary earned by the petitioner in the months of August and September, 2018, are sought to be placed on record; a perusal of which shows that in the month of August, 2018, the petitioner earned a net pay of Rs.30,379/- and in the month of September, 2018, he earned Rs.32,109/- out of a total gross salary of Rs.34,916/-.

The applicant-petitioner also seeks to place on record a copy of what is stated to be a passbook of a Small Savings Scheme subscribed to by him in a post office, showing that he has been depositing money @ Rs.1,000/- per month towards each subscription, there being two subscriptions (as contended), for the benefit of each of his two daughters.

[However, a perusal of the photocopy of the passbook shows that the account number in one of the schemes is 19500017 with there being in fact an interpolation in what is stated to be the passbook for the second

subscription, with the numeral 3 added after the letter 7, the rest of the digits being the same as in the first subscription].

He also seeks to place on record a translated copy of the order shown to be passed by the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhadra (Rajasthan) on 9.3.2017, in proceedings stated to be conducted under Section 125 of the Cr.P.C., by which the petitioner has been ordered to pay Rs.3,000/- per month to his wife, i.e. the respondent herein, and Rs.1500/- to each of his minor children, the total thereby coming to Rs.7,500/- per month, with the petitioner and respondent stated to have 3 children.

The application is allowed subject to just exceptions and the aforesaid documents are ordered to be taken on record as Annexures P-6 to P-8 with the accompanying petition.

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With the petitioner shown to be earning as net amount of Rs.32,000/- per month as of September, 2018, I see no reason to interfere with the impugned order, the respondent also having to look after the 3 minor children of the couple.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed.
