Plaintiff-petitioner is in the revision petition against the order passed by the learned trial Court dated 15.12.2016 refusing to strike out the cross-examination of an official of the Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. by learned counsel for defendant No.3.

The plaintiff-petitioner was filed a suit for permanent injunction restraining the defendants from disconnecting the electric connection. Subsequently, the suit was amended and relief of mandatory injunction was added as the electricity connection had been disconnected during the pendency of the suit.

During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the parties admit that in a separate suit filed by defendant No.3 for possession, decree for possession has been passed which has been upheld upto this Court and pursuant to the aforesaid decree, the possession has been delivered to

defendant No.3.

In view of the aforesaid, in the considered opinion of this Court, the present revision petition as well as the suit filed before the learned trial Court has become infructuous.

In view thereof, the present revision petition as well as the suit titled as 'S. Jatinder Singh Vs. Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd.' shall be deemed to have been dismissed as infructuous.

A copy of the order be sent to the learned trial Court for consigning the file of the suit to the record room.
