LISA GILL,J

This petition has been filed seeking expeditious disposal of the execution proceedings initiated by the present petitioners.

It is submitted that vide order dated 18.02.2017, passed by the learned Rent Controller, Kurukshetra, eviction of the respondents from the demised premises was ordered. It is contended that no appeal whatsoever has been preferred by the tenant. There is no stay of order dated 18.02.2017, by any Court of competent jurisdiction. In the execution petition filed by the petitioner, warrant of possession was issued vide order dated 19.08.2017 for 11.09.2017. The respondent-tenant did not even appear before the learned Executing Court and was proceeded against *ex parte*. However, the matter is still hanging fire. The matter was adjourned to 20.12.2018 vide order dated 16.07.2018 by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Kurukshetra.

Heard.

The matter is pending before the learned Executing Court for 20.12.2018. This Court is sanguine that the learned Executing Court is

alive to the facts and circumstances of the case and shall take necessary steps for the expeditious disposal of the proceedings in accordance with the provisions without any delay.

No ground for any further direction is made out in this petition, at this stage.

Petition is accordingly disposed of.
