Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that in spite of orders having been specifically passed way back on 16.01.2017 under Section 174 of the Motor Vehicles Act and the matter having been listed before the District Collector for more than one year, nothing tangible has resulted, thus putting to a great hardship the claimant/petitioner Umesh Kumar.

In view of this inordinate delay, impels this Court to issue directions to the concerned Collector, Ludhiana to expedite the matter and take appropriate action immediately as per law and ensure that unnecessary adjournments are not given on frivolous pretext.
