Ld. Counsel for both sides submit that the parties have come to an amicable settlement that the petitioner shall peacefully deliver vacant possession of the demised premises to the respondent-landlady latest by 31st May, 2019, shall pay up the accumulative arrears, if any, before the end of December, 2018, and, shall continue to pay *mesne* profit @ Rs.10,000/- per month to the landlady till she actually vacates the premises.

In view of the aforesaid understanding arrived at between the parties, the revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn with a further direction that in the event of the petitioner being unable to abide by the commitment as expressed through her counsel above, she would be liable to face legal consequences, and any default in payment of arrears or current *mesne* profits as undertaken above shall also render the decree liable to be executed forthwith.
