By this petition, the petitioner-defendant has challenged the order of the learned trial Court dated 23.07.2014 (copy Annexure P-5), by which his application under Order 6 Rule 17 read with Section 151 CPC has been dismissed.

Notice of motion having been issued in the petition on 28.10.2014, with notice regarding stay having also been issued at that stage, returnable on November 20, 2014, thereafter, the matter had been adjourned from time to time, with Mr. Sanjiv Manrai, learned senior counsel appearing for the respondent-plaintiff, on 16.03.2018 having submitted that despite the fact that there is no stay ordered by this Court, the trial Court is not proceeding with the matter (simply because notice regarding stay was issued on 28.10.2014).

On the last date of hearing also none had appeared for the petitioner and today again none appears for him.

Dismissed in default.

It is made clear that since no stay on any proceeding was ordered in any case, there is no interim order that requires to be vacated.
