The present revision petition was ordered to be heard
along with CR No.7004 of 2014.

While issuing notice of motion in the aforesaid petition
on 09.10.2017, following order was passed:-

“Heard.

Notice of motion for 09.01.2018.

*In the meantime, the petitioner shall deposit an
amount of Rs.5 lakh within a period of 15 days and another
Rs.5 lakh within a period of 15 days thereafter. In case, the
petitioner deposits Rs.10 lakh in the aforesaid manner
within a period of one month, proceedings with regard to*

sale of the house shall be kept in abeyance till the next date of hearing. The amount deposited by the petitioner shall be released in favour of respondent No.1 but without prejudice to its right to contest the present petition.”

Thereafter in the order dated 13.11.2017 passed in the aforesaid petition, it was clarified that the order passed by this Court is conditional subject to deposit of Rs.10 lakhs.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.1 submitted that the amount of Rs.10 lakhs has not been deposited at all till date.

The aforesaid fact has not been refuted by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of above, no indulgence can be granted in this revision petition. The same is accordingly dismissed.
