This revision has been filed against the concurrent orders of the Courts below allowing ejectment of the petitioners-tenant from the demised premises.

Mr. Tarun Jindal, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of the respondent.

After instructions from their respective clients both the counsel have agreed to the following order :-

“The petitioners would undertake to vacate the premises on or before 31.01.2019. There is a slight dispute regarding the date upto which the petitioners have deposited the mesne profits. It is further clarified that any arrears on account of mesne profits and the future rent upto 31.01.2019 is fixed @ Rs.1,000/- per month. The petitioners will make the deposit of this amount upto 31.01.2019 and will furnish the undertaking

as mentioned above before the Executing Court/trial Court on or before 30.04.2018.”

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
