Respondent No.1, Vijay Pal Singh (since deceased) had filed an eviction petition against Hardeep Singh Sachar (petitioner herein), Mandeep Singh and Kanwaljit Singh, proforma respondents No.2 and 3. Learned Rent Controller, Chandigarh had dismissed the rent petition vide order dated 2.11.2013. However, the learned Appellate Authority vide order dated 1.8.2016 setting aside the order passed by the learned Rent Controller, Chandigarh allowed the petition. The respondents in the eviction petition were granted three months time to hand over the vacant possession of the demised premises to the landlord.

The present revision petition has been preferred only by Hardeep Singh Sachar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner and respondent No.1 (i) (ii), (iii) (iv) [who are legal heirs of Vijay Pal Singh, (deceased) landlord] state that the matter has been compromised between them. The petitioner is present in the Court and the keys of the demised premises have been handed over to Shri Raman Sharma, Advocate representing legal representatives of the deceased, Vijay Pal Singh. Mr. Raman Sharma states that he has instructions to state that the respondent No.1 (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) would give up the entire arrears of rent and mesne profits as against the petitioner.

Both the counsel state that in view of the aforesaid compromise, this revision petition may be dismissed as withdrawn.

Ordered accordingly.
