Learned counsel for the petitioners states that since the very suit filed by the respondent-plaintiffs has been decided by the civil Court, the present civil revision petition filed against the order dated 01.09.2017 (Annexure P-5), whereby the application of the respondent-plaintiffs seeking amendment of the plaint was allowed, has become infructuous. He, however, prays that the petitioners be granted liberty to raise all possible pleas before the appellate Court.

In view of the fact that the suit has been decided by the civil Court, the present revision petition has been rendered as infructuous and is dismissed as such. However, the petitioners shall be at liberty to raise all possible pleas before the appellate Court, as available under law.
