Learned trial Court in exercise of its discretion and for valid reasons recorded has chosen to set aside an ex parte decree passed and permitted defendant No.3 namely the Director, Airport Authority, Raja Sansi, District, Amritsar to contest the suit. No doubt, learned trial Court has recorded that defendant No.3 was served, however, the Court taking into consideration the fact and the circumstances of the present case including the fact that one official of the authority has not correctly supplied the information to the concerned authority depriving it of an opportunity to contesting the suit, has chosen to set aside the ex parte decree. The decree is for possession of the land measuring 34 kanals and 12 marlas.

Keeping in view the fact that the cogent reasons have been given, this Court does not find any good ground to interfere. However,

since the suit is stated to have been instituted in the year 2001, learned Civil Court is directed to re-decide the suit, within the period of one year positively.

Revision petition is dismissed.
