In a suit for specific performance, the parties had compromised. However, vide the impugned order, the trial Court took a view that the compromise appears to be collusive and not within the purview of the present controversy. Hence, the compromise was declined and plaintiff was directed to lead evidence. No reason has been given as to how the Court finds the same to be collusive.

As such, the impugned order is set aside. The matter is remanded back to the successor Court of learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Chandigarh, to re-hear the said matter and decide the same by passing a speaking order. Needless to say that for this purpose, suit which is stated to have adjourned sine die, shall be restored and heard.

The present revision petition stands disposed of accordingly.
