Learned counsel, at the outset, pointed out that deficiency in court fee has been made good. He further submits that no doubt counter claim against a co-defendant exclusively is not maintainable, however, the counter claim could be treated as a separate suit.

In the considered opinion of this court, it would be more appropriate, if the petitioner files an application before the trial court to this effect, which shall be decided by the court without being influenced by the impugned order passed.
