In the present case, the revision petition has been filed against the order passed by the learned Executing Court dismissing the execution petition filed by the Decree Holder.

Today, counsel for the respondent alongwith respondent-Baldev Singh are present in the Court. The respondent namely Baldev Singh, has made a statement that he has neither interfered nor will ever interfere in the possession of the Decree Holder with respect to the land measuring 9 marlas which was decreed vide judgment and decree dated 23.07.2004, which became final between the parties. The respondent has further stated that he has not placed any firewood in the disputed land.

The respondent would remain bound by his statement and if the respondent ever violates his undertaking as given to this Court, the

petitioner-Decree Holder shall be at liberty to file a complaint before the police authorities who would ensure that the decree is complied with.

In view of the aforesaid, the present revision petition is disposed of.
