Heard.

Both the learned counsels for parties are agreed that petitioner Teja Singh will pay Rs. 90,000/- to respondent in complete satisfaction of claim of respondent-DH. It is stated on behalf of petitioner that after release of amount of gratuity by FCI, Moga, payment will be made within two weeks to respondent-DH.

In these circumstances, authorities of FCI, Moga, are directed to release the amount of gratuity of the petitioner as admissible to him and then petitioner is directed to bring a demand draft of Rs. 90,000/- in favour of respondent-DH and produce the same before the Executing

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Court to be paid to respondent-decree holder and on payment of Rs. 90,000/-, the execution shall be deemed to have been fully satisfied. However, it is further directed that if JD fails to make the payment as abovenoted, he shall be liable to pay the entire decretal amount which can be recovered by use of coercive methods by Executing Court. Consequently, instant revision is disposed of.
