1. Prayer in the revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of directions to respondent No.1 to decide the petition under Section 13-A of the Punjab Village Common Land (Regulation) Act, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') expeditiously within a time frame on the ground that the petition was filed by the petitioner in the year 2014.

2. In view of the nature of order proposed to be passed, I do not deem it necessary to issue notice to the respondents, as the same would entail delay of conclusion of proceedings as also incurring of expenditure by the respondents.
