Defendant-petitioner is in the revision petition against order passed by the trial Court dated 26.11.2015 dismissing an application filed to get the agreement to sell dated 24.04.2001 examined from the Central Forensic Science Laboratory, Chandigarh to get an opinion of Handwriting Expert. The Court has noticed that the plaintiff has already examined a handwriting expert and his report has been exhibited. The court has further found that the application filed is not maintainable as the courts cannot be expected to collect evidence on behalf of the parties. The court has further held that the application is only a dilating tactics to delay the trial of the case.

This Court has heard learned counsel for the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner could not point out any statutory provisions which may bind the court to send a document, execution whereof is being disputed to a Central Forensic Science Laboratory.

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In view thereof, there is no ground to interfere in the order passed by the learned trial Court in the present revision petition.
