This revision has been filed against the concurrent orders of the Courts below allowing ejectment of the petitioners-tenants from the demised premises.

Today on instructions from their clients the learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioners will not press this petition on merits and will vacate the premises voluntarily on or before 30.09.2018 without forcing the respondent-landlord to file an execution petition and undertake to pay contractual rent upto 30.09.2018 in advance by 03rd April, 2018 and pay the other admissible charges regularly.

Mr. Abhijeet Partap Singh Chaudhary, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of the respondent and after taking instructions from the respondent has also accepted this offer on the condition that the petitioners file an undertaking to the above effect and give the entire rent upto 30.09.2018 to the respondent before the Executing Court/Rent

Controller on or before 03.04.2018, failing which, this revision should be deemed to be dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has accepted this condition.

In the circumstances, the revision petition is disposed of in the above terms, and subject to the deposit all arrears and future rent on or before 03.04.2018.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
