

It comes out that petitioner husband does not deny that he is working in Punjab National Bank and getting income of Rs. 35,000/-. Claim of present petitioner is that his wife is M.Sc. Physics, B. Ed. and worked as extension lecturer in Government Women College, Narnaul, from August, 2015, to January. 2016, and getting monthly salary of Rs. 18,000/-. However, the learned District Judge, Narnaul, has observed that application was filed on 15.11.2016. Therefore, it cannot be said that wife is

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having salary by doing job as extension lecturer even on the date of filing of application. There is nothing on file to show that on the date of filing of application, wife was working and earning something. The job of extension lecturer itself is a temporary job. There is no illegality or infirmity in impugned order. Consequently, revision is dismissed.
