[1] Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, states that the only prayer of the petitioners is for issuance of directions to the learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Div.), Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar to decide application dated 24.05.2018 filed by the petitioners for providing police help for enforcing injunction order dated 14.05.2018 in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.

[2] Learned counsel contends that petitioner No.1 who is a widow along with her adopted daughter had filed a suit for declaration that they are owners in possession of the land detailed in the suit as also for passing a decree for permanent injunction restraining the defendants/respondents from interfering in the possession of the suit land fully detailed in the head note of the plaint and that an injunction order was passed in their favour on 14.05.2018. However, respondents who are members of the family of the deceased-husband of petitioner No.1 are interfering in the peaceful possession of the petitioners despite interim injunction order having been

passed on 14.05.2018 in favour of the petitioners restraining the respondents from interfering in the peaceful possession of the petitioners. Learned counsel contends that in the circumstances, the petitioners moved an application on 24.05.2018 before the learned trial Court for police help which has not been decided till date.

[4] In view of the nature of the order proposed to be passed, I do not deem it appropriate to issue notice to the respondents since the same would only delay the decision of the application, besides, would entail incurring of unnecessary expenditure by the respondents.

[5] In the circumstances, the revision petition is disposed of by directing the learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Div.), Bilaspur, District Yamunanagar to decide application dated 24.05.2018 filed by the petitioners for seeking police help in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible, preferably within six weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
